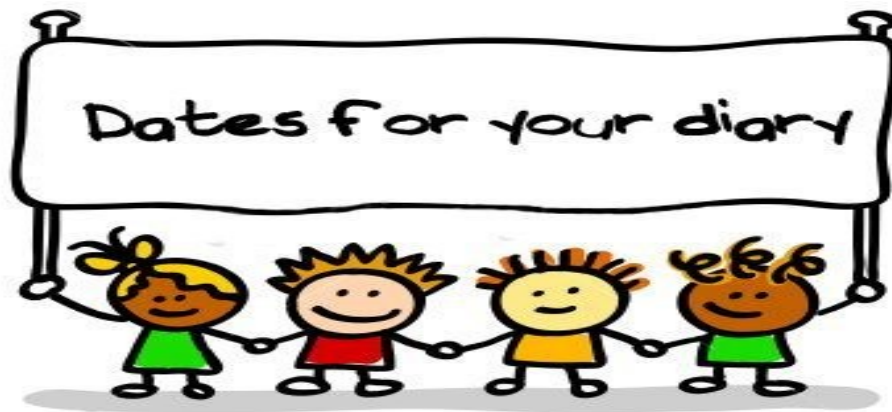

in our school, with friends, family and community.

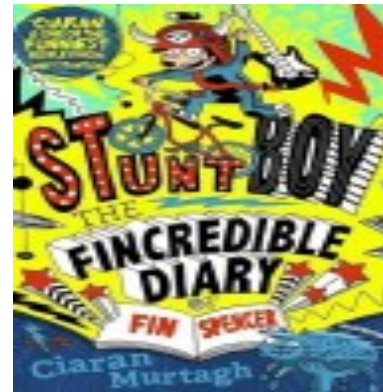

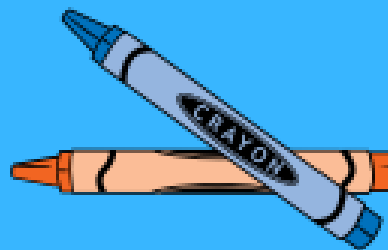

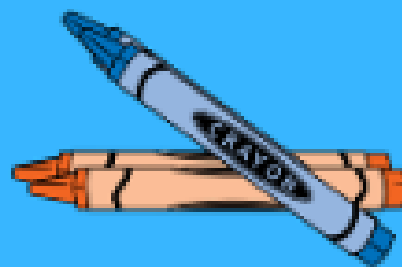
