Code of Conduct for All Visitors and Those in Contact

1. At Temple Ewell Church of England Primary School, we promote respect and a caring attitude between all adults and children. As a Church school, we ask that all staff, families and visitors exercise patience, use respectful language and show tolerance and courtesy at all times which includes face to face, telephone or email contact.
2. Any case of verbal and/or physical abuse or threatening behaviour towards members of our school staff will result in the perpetrator being asked to leave the school premises. It may result in a ban and, where appropriate prosecution under Section 3,4 or 5 of the Public Order act 1986. All incidents will be logged.
3. Visitors are requested not to smoke or vape on school premises or at the school gate.
4. All persons must follow health and safety regulations at all times to ensure the safety of themselves, and others.
